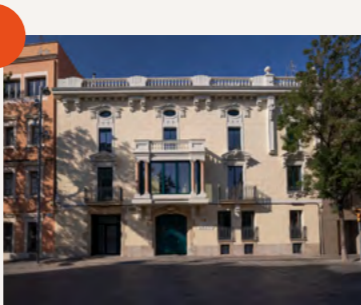
PRACTICAL INFORMATION

DISTANCE 5.3 km in total (3.7 km without reaching the Abbey Mill)



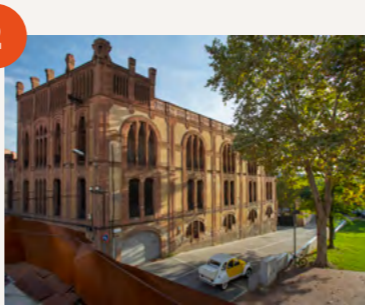
Accessible route except for Trav. de Sant Antoni (point of interest 20). We recommend continuing the route along Carrer Llagasta.



Cal Valls - Cal Maco

Pl. de la Creu, 18

Dating from 1914, it is by the architect Josep Pausas Coll. It is currently a hostel and visitor centre.



Cal Sabater

C. del Sol, 24-26

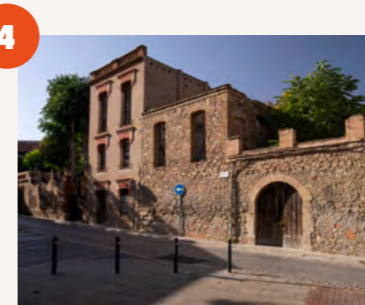
Modernist tannery by the architect Josep Ros i Ros (1912-1919). Known as the "tanners' cathedral" because of its majesty.



Old Bas Tannery

C. del Sol, 19

Old tannery dating from 1880, currently renovated by the architect Xavier Andrés as a gastronomic space and hotel "Somiatruites".



Linares Tannery

C. del Sol, 15

Built in 1900. The modernist architect Josep Pausas Coll renovated it in 1922.



Cal Boyer - Leather Museum of Igualada

C. Dr. Mercader, 1

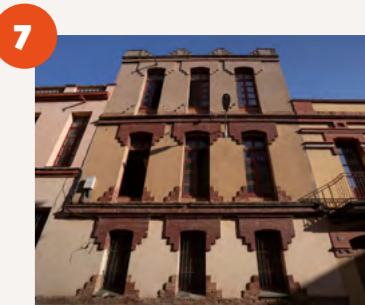
Old cotton factory (1897), formed by two two-storey industrial buildings topped with a truss roof.



Muleteer Museum

C. dels Traguiners, 5

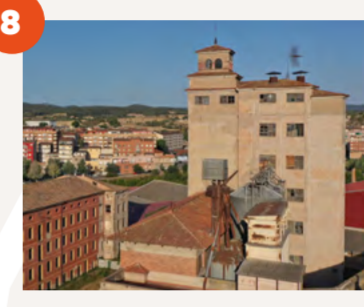
Dedicated to muleteers, it shows the evolution of the transport and the different related trades. Antoni Ros Collection.



Colom Tannery

C. de la Creueta, 19-21

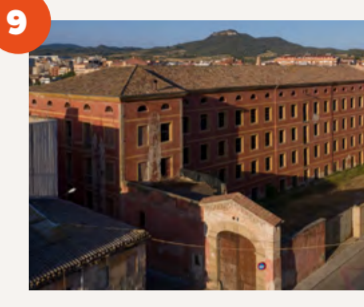
Built in 1919 as a tannery and reconverted in 1925 as a dwelling, it is part of a group of important tanneries on the same street.



Grifé Flour Mill

C. Sant Ignasi, 2

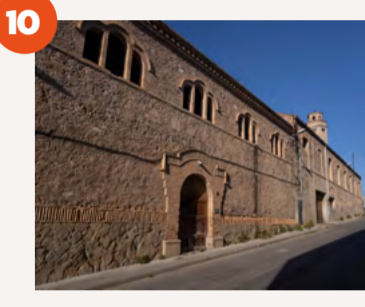
Built in 1946 by the architect Bonaventura Bassegoda. The building's high tower is one of the most characteristic elements of the district.



La Igualadina Cotton Factory

C. Joan Godó Lluçà, 2-6

Old steam textile factory built in 1841, considered a symbol of the industrial revolution in Catalonia. National Site of Cultural Interest.



Vineyard Union Winery and Oil Mill

C. Joan Abat, 6

Modernist building designed by the architect Cèsar Martinell i Brunet in 1921. The austerity of the façade hides the grandeur of its interior.



Cal Sistaré / Vapor de Baix

C. de la Creueta, 35

Textile factory from 1855 comprising the industrial building that is visible from the street, a second building at the back and a patio with chimney.



El Pallerols Dyeworks Chimney

C. del Rec, 2-6

Dating from 1882. The dyeworks has been closed for several years, but the chimney has become an icon of the silhouette of the district.



Bella Tannery

C. del Rec, 21-23

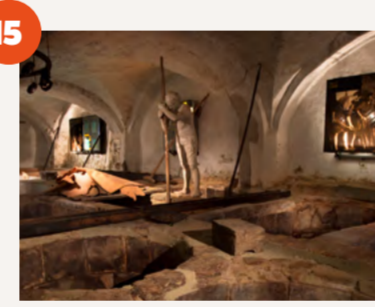
Old tannery from the 19th century renovated in 1911. Igualada City Council restored it and it has been the headquarters of Leather Cluster Barcelona since 2015.

C. del Rec

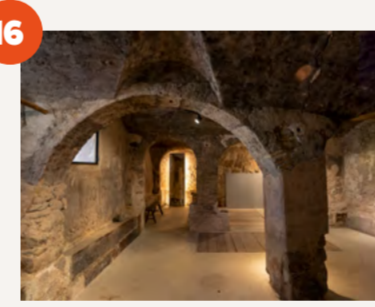
An open irrigation canal between C. San Faust and C. del Dr. Joan Mercader, which supplied the surrounding tanneries.



Cal Granotes

Baixada de la Unió, 26

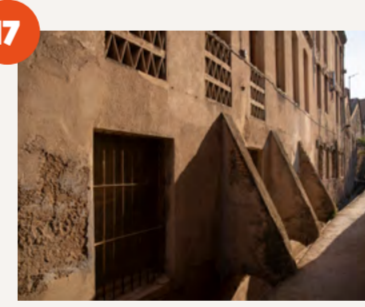
Old 18th century tannery now converted into a museum. It shows how hides were tanned before industrialisation.



Cal Segall (and Cal Valls)

Baixada de la Unió, 11

The oldest documented tannery. It still has the original structure of arches and vaults. It currently houses the co-working space "Espais del Rec".

C. del Rec

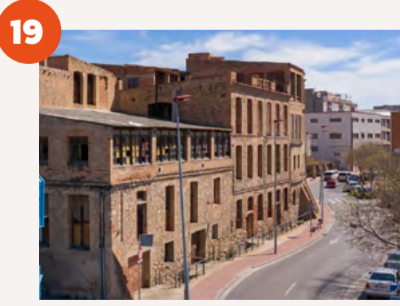
Between C. Sant Faust and C. del Sol, the canal preserves its characteristic architectural elements.



Elctra Igualadina

C. del Rec, 41

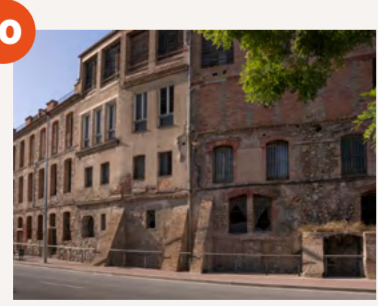
Thermal power plant built in 1903, work of the architect Isidre Gili. A group of buildings of modernist characteristics.



Castellort Tannery (Cal Ton del Jaume)

Rda. del Rec, 61 / C. St. Antoni de Baix, 10

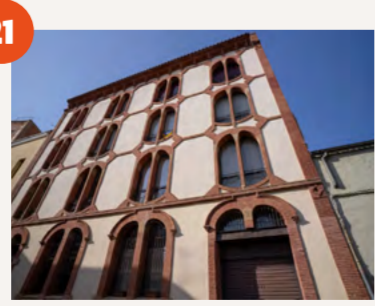
The family home faces C. Sant Antoni and still has the inscription "AC 1886".

Rda. del Rec, 63 / Trav. St. Antoni, 4

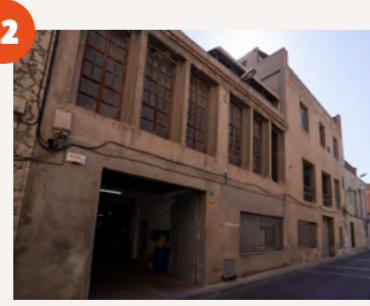
In the past, rainwater filtered through the side alley forming gullies.



Pelfort Tannery

C. Sant Antoni de Baix, 5

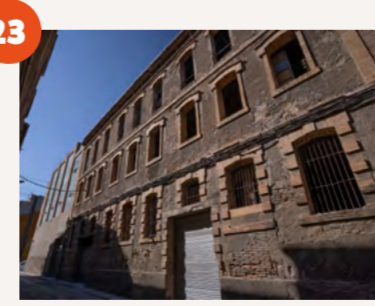
Old tannery from 1917 with a modernist façade by Josep Pausas i Coll. Renovated as dwellings.



Combalia Tannery

C. Sant Antoni de Baix, 56-58

Originating from the old Cal Carol (1823) and Cal Cabòries Pausas i Coll. It is still an active tannery.



Vives Gibert Tannery

C. Sant Antoni de Baix, 47

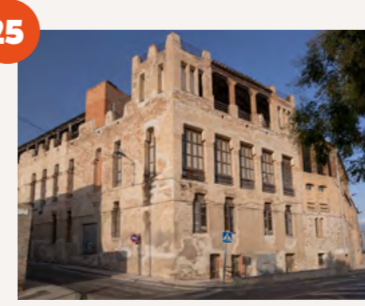
Built in 1901 by Marià Vives i Gibert and renovated in 1950. Its traditional industrial façade is outstanding.



Biosca Factory

C. St. Antoni de Baix, 49-51

Old knitwear factory (Escorpion) built in 1927 and extended in 1961 by Joan Bassegoda.



Balcells Tannery

C. del Rec, 113

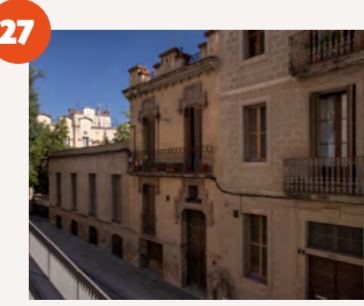
The origin of the building dates from 1890. The renovations from 1914 and 1925 are the work of the architect Ignasi M. Colomer i Homs.



Abbey Mill

Rda. del Rec, s/n/ C. Moli de l'Abadia

The origins of the irrigation canal and this flour mill date back to the 12th century. The canal ended in the Mill pond.



Casa Sala

C. Concepció, 4

Dating from 1918, a work of Josep Pausas. The modernist set of buildings is completed by the adjoining Company and Barral houses.



Martí Enrich Tannery

C. del Sol, 36-38 and c. Sant Faust

Built by Martí Enrich i Llop in 1919, work of Josep Pausas. It was extended with the elegant, exposed brick building in 1956.
